

In a perfect world:

The stage is a minimum of 12 x 24 or larger and set flush against a back wall (for safety)

There are stairs center front, and a second set side stage. If a third set is on the other side, GREAT!

Speakers are set as close to the corners or on tripods off the stage, in the corners of the stage-front.

The small prop table is set to the side, and the mixer or receiver is set upon this prop table,

There is also adequate power nearby for the performers music, microphones, etc.

12 to 20 chairs are set on stage. The performer can position them where and how he wants.

There is an isle in the middle of the theater for easier access to and from the stage.
